Application Procedure

Eligibility

- A. Applicant must have been a member in good standing of HomeTown Federal Credit Union for at least six months prior to the application date.
- B. Applicant must be a graduating high school senior pursuing post high school education during the 2021/2022 school year.
- C. Applicant must be planning to attend a private or public college, university, community college or technical college accredited by the U.S. Department of Education. Awards will be disbursed within 90 days of the application deadline and checks will be made payable to the college or university.
- D. Winners will be notified by phone.

Awards

Up to four scholarships may be awarded; two scholarships in the amount of \$1000.00 and two scholarships in the amount of \$500.00.

Application Requirements

- 1. Applicants must submit:
 - Original signed application (including the student's Credit Union member number) and the link to the YouTube video.
 - Accomplishment list including: honors, awards, recognitions and achievements, extra-curricular activities, volunteer and employment experiences.
 - Official high school transcripts with GPA from the most recent semester.
 - Letters of recommendation from two people within the community (cannot be related to applicant)
- 2. Completed applications must be submitted no later than 5:00 p.m. on Friday, April 9, 2021.

Entries must be e-mailed to: scholarship@hometowncu.coop

Late or incomplete applications will not be considered and will be disqualified. Electronic applications only, no paper applications will be considered.

3. Employees and volunteers of HomeTown Credit Union and their immediate family members are not eligible to apply.

Judging

Judging will be done by a committee of impartial judges selected by Credit Union management. All decisions are final.

Award Procedures

- Winners will be informed by phone within 30 days of application deadline.
- Scholarship funds will be presented to the winners. Funds may be issued jointly to the winner and the school they will be attending. If a school has not been decided on, HomeTown Credit Union may hold the funds until notified of the school selected.

Authority of HomeTown Credit Union
